

A RESOLUTION BY THE COLUMBIA COUNTY, FLORIDA BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, ENDING A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY DUE TO AN ONGOING PANDEMIC EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Columbia County Board of County Commissioners adopted Local State of Emergency Resolution number 2020R-07, on March 18, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Columbia County been in emergency protective actions for this response since that date; and

WHEREAS, the availability of testing and providing of vaccine has increased around Columbia County; and

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Health Department has concluded Point of Distribution (POD) vaccination sites; and

WHEREAS, Columbia County Emergency Management will continue to provide support to the Columbia County Health Department following day-to-day procedures; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbia County, Florida in Regular session duly assembled this 3rd day of June, 2021 that the COVID-19 Local State of Emergency Expires effective immediately. The expiration of this Local State of Emergency applies to all the territory within the legal boundaries of Columbia County, including, all unincorporated and incorporated areas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners hereby exercises its authority under Chapter 252.38 (3) (5), Florida Statutes, and the Columbia County Charter.


